The petitioners apprehend arrest in connection with
Turkaulia (Banjaria) P.S. Case No. 66 of 2015 registered under
Sections 147, 149, 353, 332, 333, 323, 504, 325, 307, 188, 109,
120B, 427 of the Indian Penal Code and $\frac{3}{4}$ of the Damage to
Public Property Act.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
petitioners submits that on perusal of Annexure-2, it appears that
similarly situated co-accused person has already been allowed bail
by a Bench of this Court vide Cr. Misc. No. 35285 of 2015 on



20.08.2015.
