3 10-07-2017 Challenging Rule 6(iv) and (v) of the Bihar Zila Parishad Madhyamik Evam Ucchar Madhyamik Shikshak (Niyojan Evam Seva Sarte) Niyamavli, 2012 and contending that the procedure being followed for awarding 5 marks to those who have passed graduation with honours is ultra vires to the Constitution of India and discriminatory in nature, this writ petition has been filed.

Merely because 5 marks are being granted to those who have passed graduation with honours, we find no error or



violation of any constitutional provision in the rule warranting consideration.

The writ petition is dismissed.
