ORAL ORDER

2 17-11-2017 The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with Saharsa P.S. Case No. 885 of 2017, registered for offences punishable under Sections 363 and 365 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner and other co-accused of this case is of kidnapping the minor daughter of the informant.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that girl has been recovered and her statement under Section 164 Cr.P.C was recorded, in which the only allegation made against the petitioner that he was present with the main accused of this case, who with help of two others, kidnapped her. Further petitioner has no criminal antecedent and has been in custody since 01.09.2017.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides, in view of the above facts, let the petitioner above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail



bonds of Rs. 25,000 (Rs. Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned CJM, Saharsa, in connection with Saharsa P.S. Case No. 885 of 2017, subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned Court.
- (ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- (iii) The petitioner shall cooperate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court and on the event of failure on his part to appear before the court below on two consecutive dates without showing any genuine reasons, the prosecution is free to move for cancellation of his bail.
