ORAL ORDER

- 2 27-11-2017 The issue in question with regard to providing reservation and job to the members of transgender community has already been decided by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of **National Legal Services Authority Vs. Union of India and others, (2014)5 Supreme Court Cases 438** and, therefore, now once the Supreme Court has already laid down the guidelines and principles and rendered the decision for the aggrieved persons to seek enforcement of the rights available to them, in case of a



particular instance of violation of the guidelines laid down by the Supreme court, aggrieved persons are to ventilate the grievances in accordance with law, but for the said purpose again a Public Interest Litigation is not called for on the same very issue.

With the aforesaid observation and liberty, this application stands disposed of.
