ORAL ORDER

6 14-09-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned counsel
appearing on behalf of O.P. No.2 and the learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with
Compliant Case No. 1887 (C) of 2015, registered under Section
498(A) of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3/4 of the Dowry
Prohibition Act.

The accusation is of torturing and harassment of the
complainant/O.P. No.2 by her husband and other in-laws due to non-
fulfillment of demand of dowry and removing her along with her
minor child from the matrimonial house after snatching her personal
belongings.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on the
joint prayer of the parties, the matter was referred to the Mediation
Centre, Patna High Court, Patna for settlement of dispute between the



petitioner and O.P. No.2, who are husband and wife, where the matter was settled and, accordingly, petitioner went to his Sasural to take his wife O.P. No.2, but she was not ready to go with the petitioner.

On the other hand, learned counsel appearing on behalf of O.P. No.2 submits that petitioner has not approached the O.P. No.2.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the S.D.J.M. Gaya in connection with Compliant Case No. 1887 of 2015, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
