Inter alia contending that under the scheme formulated by the State Government for granting a sum of Rs.6,000/- to every member of a deprived family, who is affected by flood, under the Welfare measure, the people of Nakata Diyara Gram Panchayat in Block Patna Sadar District-Patna have not been granted the said benefit, the petitioner claiming to be an inhabitant of police station Digha, Patna has filed this writ petition in public interest and the direction sought for is that a sum of Rs.6,000/- be distributed to the



members of the deprived families under the Flood Relief Welfare Scheme.

The petitioner represents the cause of the people at large and in a public interest writ petition of the nature, we are not inclined to issue any mandamus general in nature. On the contrary, an aggrieved person, who is deprived of the benefit, is granted liberty to submit a claim before the District Magistrate, Patna and the District Magistrate, Patna is directed to look into the individual claim of the person concerned and settled it in accordance with law.

With the aforesaid liberty to the individual person, the matter stands disposed of.
