Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and counsel for the State.

In the present case, the petitioner is challenging the order dated 13.2.2017 passed by the Collector, Madhepura in E.C. Act (Confiscation) Case No. 12 of 2016, whereby and whereunder, the Bolero Pickup Van, bearing Registration No. BR-43G-1574, has been confiscated under the Essential Commodities Act.

The final order has been passed. The petitioner, if so advised, may file an appeal raising all the points before the appellate authority. If the petitioner files such an appeal, the appellate authority will dispose of the same in accordance with law. The appellate



authority, while consideration the issue of limitation, will take into consideration the pendency of the present writ application before this Court.

With the aforementioned observation, this application is disposed of.
