ORAL ORDER

2 10-08-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

The Petitioner who is in custody seeks bail in connection with **Ballia P.S. Case No. 68 of 2017** registered for the offence punishable under Section 366 of the Indian Penal Code.

The Prosecution case is that informant Shobha Devi lodged a complaint on 05.04.2017 at about 6:00 pm alleging that Nirmala Devi enticed her daughter Nitu Kumari and took her to Ballia Market, where she handed over her daughter to four persons including the petitioner. The girl was recovered and in her statement under Section 164 of the Cr.P.C before the 1st Class, Judicial Magistrate, Begusarai stated that on account of quarrel with her Bhabhi, she left the home and went to her Maternal Aunt's (Mausi) house at Saharsa. Subsequently, when the brother of the victim girl reached Saharsa searching her,



then she returned with him.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner named above be released on bail upon furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned **C.J.M. Begusarai** in connection with **Ballia P.S. Case No. 68 of 2017.**
