2 21-09-2017 Heard the parties.

This application, for grant of anticipatory bail, arises out of Rosara P.S. Case No. 84/17, disclosing offences under Sections 366, 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he is not named in the F.I.R. and he was working as labour in the house of the informant. The named accused Pramod Kumar Das has been granted regular bail. It is alleged that the petitioner was also instrumental in getting the marriage solemnized between the informant's daughter and Pramod Kumar Das.

Be that as it may, since Pramod Kumar Das has been granted regular bail, let the petitioner above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within six weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees



Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Rosara, Samastipur in connection with Rosara P.S. Case No. 84/2017, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

This is subject to the condition that the petitioner shall present himself before the police/Court, as the case may be, as and when required and in the event of failure on his part to appear before the Court on two consecutive occasions, his bail bond shall be liable to be cancelled.
