2 12-12-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP
for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered under Sections 467, 468, 120B of the I.P.C. as well as Sections 27(A), 27(C), 27(B), 28, 28(A), 36(A)(C) of Drugs & Cosmetics Act and Sections 7(i), 7(ii) of Drugs Control Order and Sections 47, 50 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Allegation is that expired alcoholic and homeopathic drugs have been recovered.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. It is



alleged that premises in question was given on rent by the petitioner to one Ramesh Kumar Pathak, from where expired alcoholic and homeopathic drugs are said to have been recovered. Nothing incriminating has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner had no knowledge regarding the alleged incident. There is no compliance of Section 100 Cr.P.C.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest/surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge, Excise, Patna in connection with Alamganj P.S. case No.154 of 2017, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
