ORAL ORDER

2 **01-07-2017** Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned APP for the State.

This is a case registered under Sections 3,5,18 of the Bihar Mahua Flower Act.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that when the petitioners came to Masaurhi Railway Station for boarding the train and arrived at platform, on mere suspicion they have been implicated in the case. He further submits that from perusal of the FIR it would be apparent that Mahua Flowers have been recovered from the sleeper boggy of the train and not from the conscious possession of the petitioners. He further submits that for such



allegations the petitioners are in custody since 09.03.2017.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, prayer for bail of the petitioners is allowed. Let the petitioners above named be released on bail on his furnishing bonds of Rs 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Special Judge Excise Act/4th Additional Sessions Judge, Patna in Spl. Case No. 812 of 2017 arising out of Jehanabad (Taregna) G.R.P.S Case No. 13 of 2017.
