Petitioner apprehends arrest in connection with Dulhin Bazar P.S. Case No. 162 of 2016 registered for the offence punishable under section 7 of the Essential Commodities Act.

Learned counsels appearing for the petitioner submits that petitioner is not named in the first information report. He is the bona fide owner of the vehicle in question. Petitioner has no concern with the seized kerosene oil. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions of advanced on behalf of the parties, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender within a period of four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two
