2 10-08-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioner is languishing in custody since 04.06.2017
in connection with Complaint Case No. 584/2016 for the offences
instituted under Sections 323, 341, 498(A), 494 of the IPC and ¾
of the D.P. Act in which the court below found prima facie case
under Sections 498(A) of the IPC and 4 of the D.P. Act for
summoning the petitioner.

The prosecution story, in brief, is that the accused
persons including the petitioner tortured the complainant due to
non-fulfilment of demand of dowry.



It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner is in custody since 04.06.2017. He has got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation of tampering with the witnesses alleged against the petitioner. He has falsely been implicated in the present case due to petty family dispute. The case is triable by the Magistrate. The petitioner has further relied upon the judgment of this Court in the case of Md. Naimul Haque Ansari @ Naimul Haque Ansari & Ors. Vs. The State of Bihar, reported in 2006(3) PLJR 182.

On behalf of the State, it has been submitted that the petitioner is named in the complaint case.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned S.D.J.M. Rohtas at Sasaram in connection with Complaint Case No. 584/2016.
