5 14-11-2017 Heard learned counsels for the petitioners and the State.

Petitioners apprehend arrest in connection with Sasaram (T) (Darigao) P.S. Case No. 148 of 2017 registered for the offence punishable under section 307 and other allied sections of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that they have been falsely implicated in this case due to previous enmity on account of admitted land dispute between the parties. During investigation witnesses have not named these petitioners. The allegations levelled is of firing, however the injury report does not support the same as there is no fire arm injury. Petitioners are men of clean antecedent.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the



submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender within a period of four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sasaram, Rohtas in connection with Sasaram (T) (Darigao) P.S. Case No. 148 of 2017 subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
