2 15-09-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

This is an application for bail in connection with Sasaram
(Tilauthu) P.S.Case No. 930 of 2017 registered for the offences
punishable under Sections 30(a), 34 and 35 of Bihar Excise Act.

Allegation is of recovery of 5 litres of Mahua liquor.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is that he
has falsely been implicated in this case and nothing has been
recovered from his possession and he is in custody since 4.7.2017
having no criminal antecedent.

Heard learned APP also.

Having heard both sides and in view of facts and
circumstances, let petitioner, above named, be released on bail on
furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand)
with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the
