2 14-11-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends arrest in connection with
Complaint Case No. 2150 of 2016 registered under Sections 420
of the Indian Penal Code and 138 of the N.I. Act.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
submits that petitioner is innocent. He is a reputed businessman
and has committed no offence as alleged. On perusal of the
Annexure nos. P-2 and P-3, it appears that prior to this case,
petitioner has been made accused for the offence under sections
406, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120B of the I.P.C. but in which he has
been granted bail.



Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the A.C.J.M.-IX, Saran at Chapra in connection with Complaint Case No. 2150 of 2016, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
