2 22-03-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and
learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioner is languishing in custody for the
offences punishable under Sections 302/34 of the Indian Penal
Code.

Three accused persons allegedly assaulted to
deceased Bira Sah as a result whereof he died during the course of
treatment.

Submission of the petitioner is that allegation is
general and omnibus and petitioner is a female.

Considering the general and omnibus allegation
and the fact that petitioner is a female, let petitioner, above named,
be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Ten



Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned 13th Additional Sessions Judge, East Champaran, Motihari/Successor Court, in connection with Sessions Trial No.129 of 2017, arising out of Patahi P.S. Case No.100 of 2016, with condition that petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation and trial of the case, failing which the Court-below shall be at liberty to take steps for cancellation of the bail-bonds of the petitioner in this case.
