ORAL ORDER

2 28-04-2017 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the State.

This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail for offence under Sections 341, 323, 324, 504, 379, 325 and 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Specific allegation is against petitioners, Chandan Pandit and Kundan Kumar, to have caused injury to Bhola Jaiswal. The doctor had found simple and single laceration on the occipital region on Bhola Jaiswal and another injury at the index finger.

Submission of the petitioners is that it is difficult to attribute as to which of the petitioners have caused the injury. However, no allegation of repetition of blow and allegation against other petitioners is general and omni



bus. The altercation took place for land dispute.

Considering the aforesaid fact, the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender, within four weeks from the date of receipt of this order, be released on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each in connection with **Barari P.S. Case No. 10 of 2017** to the satisfaction of the **Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, V, Katihar**, or successor Court, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438(2) of the Criminal Procedure Code.
