2 08-06-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection
with Mohiuddin Nagar P.S. Case No. 35 of 2017 registered under
Sections 448, 341, 323, 324, 326, 307 and 380 of the Indian Penal
Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
petitioners submits that there is case and counter case in between
the parties. Further submission is that similarly situated co-
accused namely, Kanj Kumar Singh has already been allowed bail
by a Bench of this Court vide Cr. Misc. No. 20228 of 2017 on
05.06.2017.



Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioners be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the A.C.J.M.-IV, Samastipur in connection with Mohiuddin Nagar P.S. Case No. 35 of 2017, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
