3 19-07-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in Singhia P.S. Case No. 84 of 2017 instituted for the offence under Sections-30(A)/38(i)(ii), 41(1) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

It has been submitted that there is allegation against this petitioner that 10 bottles of 375 ml. each foreign liquor has been recovered from his possession. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent. The petitioner is in custody since 25-05-2017.

In such circumstances, prayer for bail is allowed and it is ordered that the petitioner named above, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each in connection with Singhia P.S.
