Petitioner wants a report or recommendation of the High Power Commission for granting the status of Industry to the agriculture of the nation to be implemented. The question whether report and recommendation made by such a Commission should be implemented or not is a matter of policy, executive in nature, to be taken up and decided by the executive authorities and a mandamus for the same cannot be issued by this Court.

If the petitioner has any grievance, he shall have liberty to take up the issues with the executive authorities of the



Government or the legislative authorities and it would be for them to consider the grievance of the petitioner in accordance with law.

Finding no ground for indulgence exercising extra ordinary jurisdiction in the matter under Article 226 of the Constitution, the application is disposed of.
