Considering the undertaking having furnished at the end of the learned counsel for the Vigilance, this petition is disposed of with a condition that in case these documents are being not furnished to the appellant within fortnight, then in that event, State will have to pay Rs.50,000/- (fifty thousand) as cost whereunder on account of non-supply the relevant documents, the parties are forced to move pillar to post for redressal of their grievances.
