ORAL ORDER

3 14-11-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the State.

The petitioners apprehend arrest in Bibhutipur P.S.
Case No. 19 of 2017 instituted for the offence under Sections
147,148,149,323,324,307,380 and 452 of the IPC.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioners that
the instant case is a counter blast of Bibhutipur P.S. Case No. 155
of 2013 lodged by co-accused Mahesh Sahani, against the
informant and his family members. In the instant case, there is no
specific allegation against the petitioners and all the petitioners are
ladies.

In such circumstances, prayer for anticipatory bail is
allowed and it is ordered that the petitioners, named above, in the



event of their arrest or surrender in the court below within six weeks from the date of receipt/production of copy of this order, shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount in connection with Bibhutipur P.S. Case No. 19 of 2017 to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rosera, Samastipur subject to condition as laid down u/S 438 (2) of the Cr. P.C. with further conditions (1) bailors should be local having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the court concerned, (2) petitioners shall cooperate in the trial and shall be present on each and every date fixed by the court and absence on two consecutive dates without proper and reasonable reason, will automatically cancel bail bonds of the petitioners and (3) if the petitioners tamper with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioners.
