ORAL ORDER

2 17-11-2017 The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with Bhabhua P.S. Case No. 269 of 2017, registered for offences punishable under Sections 395/427 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner and others is of committing loot of Rs. 50,000/- from the informant.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that he has falsely been made accused in this case and has been named by the local people, however, nothing has been recovered from his possession and upto now no Test Identification Parade has been conducted and he has been in 12.07.2017 and so far criminal antecedent is concerned, he has been made accused in those cases after arrest in this case.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides, in view of the above facts, let



the petitioner above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 25,000 (Rs. Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned CJM, Kaimur, Bhabua, in connection with Bhabhua P.S. Case No. 269 of 2017, subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned Court.
- (ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- (iii) The petitioner shall cooperate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court and on the event of failure on his part to appear before the court below on two consecutive dates without showing any genuine reasons, the prosecution is free to move for cancellation of his bail.
