learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with Case  
No. C2-615/17 instituted for the offences under Section 30(A) of  
the Bihar Excise Act, 2016.

The allegation is recovery of 36 litres Nepali Soufi  
wine from the possession of the petitioner.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that  
nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the  
petitioner and he is in custody since 30.10.2017.

Considering the nature of accusation, the period of  
custody already undergone and the fact that he has got a clean



antecedent, I direct the petitioner named above to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.D.J.-II cum Special Judge, Excise Act, Sitamarhi in connection with Case No. C2/615/2017.
