(1) The respondent No. 1- Commissioner, Bilaspur, by its order dated 21.07.1986, appointed respondent No. 3 – Smt. Shobha Gupta on the post of Upper Division Teacher.

(2) The petitioner is a Nagar Nigam Samast Karmchari Sangh and, as such, petitioner is not the aggrieved person to question the order passed by respondent No.1 /Commissioner appointing respondent No.

3 as Upper Division Teacher and, therefore, he is not entitled to maintain this writ petition. {See **Calcutta Gas Company (Prop.) Ltd. Vs. (3) Accordingly, the writ petition being devoid of merit is liable to be and is hereby dismissed at the admission stage itself.
