He would further submit that victim compensation scheme has been amended vide Notification No.F 3-87/2011/Home-Two w.e.f. 14th September, 2016 and as per scheme major rape victim is entitled for compensation to the tune of ₹ 1,00,000/-.

2. Be that as it may, the State Government will consider the case of the petitioner and grant her compensation as per notification dated 14th September, 2016 within a period of four weeks from today.
