(1) Heard on I.A. No.01, application for condonation of delay in filing the MCC.

(2) On due consideration, I am satisfied that the applicant has succeeded in explaining the cause of delay in filing the MCC and,

therefore, I.A.No.01 is allowed. Delay in filing the MCC is condoned.

(3) Learned counsel for the applicant is heard on restoration application.

(4) The applicant is seeking restoration of Writ Petition No.806/2005 which was dismissed for want of prosecution vide order dated 25.10.2016.
