He would further submit that he may be allowed to make a representation before the Sub Divisional Officer (Revenue), Kabirdham which may be directed to be decided expeditiously.

3. The petitioner is permitted to make a representation before the Sub

Divisional Officer (Revenue), Kabirdham within a period of seven days from today along with copy of this order. If such a representation is made before the Sub Divisional Officer (Revenue), Kabirdham within the stipulated time, the Sub Divisional Officer (Revenue), Kabirdham shall look into the matter and take a decision on the petitioner's representation within a period of seven days from the date of receipt of the representation.

4. With the aforesaid observation, the writ petition finally stands disposed off.
