(1) Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner has made an application under the provisions of Chhattisgarh Rajya Upcharyagrah Tatha Rogopchar Sambandhi

Sthapnaye Anugyapan Adhiniyam, 2013 (henceforth "Adhiniyam, 2013") for registration before respondent authorities, but the same has not been considered and decided till date and, therefore, he may be permitted to file fresh application for registration before the respondent authorities and the same may be directed to be decided expeditiously.
