1. The petitioners application for registration of Paramedical Practitioner has been rejected by order dated 24.11.2015.
2. Order dated 24.11.2015 itself indicates that such an order is appealable under Section 43 of the Chhattisgarh Paramedical Council Act, 2001 before the Appellate Authority.
3. Since the order is appealable and order dated 24.11.2015 has even not been challenged by the petitioners by filing separate writ petition, it would be appropriate that the petitioners may file appeal before the Appellate Authority within 30 days from today.
