AWARD

The contesting parties to this appeal have amicably settled/compromised the dispute, which is subject matter of this appeal, voluntarily. We have also found that the terms and conditions of compromise/settlement arrived at between the contesting parties are just, proper and legal and hence are acceptable. We accordingly accept the compromise/settlement, proposed by the parties and order that in addition to the amount of compensation awarded by the Tribunal, the respondent No. 3,

The Oriental Insurance Company shall pay to the appellant a sum of **Rs. 2,75,000/- (Two Lakh Seventy Five Thousands Only)** by way of compensation, within two months from today, otherwise, interest @ 6% per annum from the date of present award, shall also be payable till its realization.
