3. Prayer appears to be fair and reasonable.

Be that as it may, the Chief Executive Officer, Jila Panchayat, Bastar is directed to consider and take a decision on the pending representation of the petitioners in accordance with Rule 18(1)(b) of the Rules of 1999 preferably within a period of three 3 months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

5. With the aforesaid observation, the writ petition stands finally disposed off.
