HON'BLE The Vacation Judge**Order On Board****22/05/2017**

1. The applicants have preferred this application for grant of bail as they are arrested in connection with Crime No.72/2017 registered in Police Station Dhamdha, District Durg for offence punishable under Section 34(2) of the Chhattisgarh Excise Act for illegally possessing 10.260 bulk liters of liquor.
2. Having heard learned counsel for the parties, having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case and considering the fact that the applicants are in jail since 17.4.2017, this Court is inclined to release them on bail. Accordingly, the application is allowed and the applicants

are directed to be released on bail on each of them executing a personal bond for a sum of Rs. 25,000/- with one surety for the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court. They are directed to appear before the trial Court on each and every date given by the said Court. It is made clear that if the applicants involve themselves in the offence of similar nature in future, this order granting bail to the applicants shall automatically stand cancelled without reference to the Bench.
