On 24.11.2016 learned Assistant Solicitor General had informed this Court that the proposal for removing toll plaza is under consideration with the



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Government and he was granted time to seek instructions. On 16.01.2017, again time was granted for the same.

Today when the matter was taken up for hearing, Mr. Vyas informed that the proposal of the State Government for removing the toll plaza at Kosa Naala has been agreed to be in principle by the Central Government and by 10th of April 2017, notification to this effect may be issued and the toll plaza would be closed. He has also produced the communication dated 23.02.2017 which is taken on record.

In view of the decision of the Central Government, nothing survives in the writ petition for adjudication. Accordingly the petition is disposed of.

If the petitioner still has some grievance he would be at liberty to proceed in accordance with law.
