(2) Learned counsel for the State/respondents submits that the impugned order dated 12.01.2017 passed by respondent No.2 i.e. District Collector, Bemetara is appealable before the appellate authority.

(3) At this stage, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to prefer an appeal before the appellate authority within a period of ten days from today.

(4) Prayer appears to be fair and reasonable.

(5) The petitioner is permitted to prefer an appeal before the appellate authority. If such appeal is filed by the petitioner within a period of ten days from today and, in turn, the appellate authority shall consider and decide the same in accordance with law and on its own merit preferably within a period of two months after hearing of both the parties from the date of receipt of appeal of the petitioner along with copy of this order.

(6) With the aforesaid observation, the writ petition stands finally disposed of. No order as to cost(s).
