1. Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner has been transferred twice within a period of 8 months. He would submit that the petitioner has complied the previous transfer order by joining at the transferred place.
2. Considering the fact that the petitioner appears to have been subjected to frequent transfer as in the present impugned order he has been transferred from Municipal Council, Bhili Charouda to Nagar Panchayat, Than Khamhariya and the petitioner is a Class-III employee, ends of justice would be served if the writ petition is disposed of with direction that in the

event the petitioner prefers representation within a period of 15 days from today before the Secretary of the concerned department, the said Secretary shall consider and decide petitioner's representation at the earliest, preferably within a period of 4 weeks.

3. Till the petitioner's representation is decided or for a period of six weeks, whichever is earlier, the impugned order shall remain stayed in respect of the petitioner and he shall be allowed to continue at his present place of posting.
