1. Challenge in the present writ petition is to the advertisement dated 9.7.2015 (Annexure P-1) and the Petitioner has also sought for a direction to the Respondents to consider his case for regularization.
2. The issue involved in the present writ petition has already been decided by this Court in a bunch of writ petitions decided on 2.1.2017, the lead case being Writ Petition (S) No. 1656 of 2016.
