AWARD**(Passed on 08.07.2017)**

He prays for reserving their right to pass a fresh order in the event of administrative exigency.

(3) Accordingly, the present Writ Petition is disposed of with the consent of the parties that the State Government shall not act upon the impugned transfer order, reserving right in favour of the State Government to pass a fresh order in the event of administrative exigency.
