(5) The writ petition is accordingly disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to prefer an appeal before the Collector, Bilaspur. If such appeal is filed by the petitioner within a period of 30 days from today and, in turn, the Collector, Bilaspur shall consider and decide the same in accordance with law, after affording proper opportunity of hearing to the parties expeditiously preferably within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
