Municipal Corporation Act, 1956 (for short "Act, 1956") , he may be

(3) Accordingly, it is directed that appellate authority would consider and dispose of the appeal by 28th August, 2017 after hearing the affected parties.

(4) At this stage, counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner's building is now sealed.

(5) Accordingly, it is directed that till the appeal is decided finally, the petitioner's building shall not be demolished.

(6) With the aforesaid observations, the writ petition stands finally disposed of.
