(1) Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 04.10.2016 passed in WP(C) No.2502/2016, the Collector, Mahasamund has directed to the Sub-Divisional Officer to submit an enquiry report, yet no action has been taken and thereafter, fresh advertisement has been issued for allotment of
