2. Be that as it may, respondent No.3 is directed to consider and decide the application of the petitioner expeditiously preferably within a period of 30 days from the date of receipt of copy of this order. However, the petitioner is

at liberty to file fresh application, if any before the said authority for redressal of her grievance.

3. With the aforesaid observation, the writ petition stands finally disposed of. No order as to costs.
