The petitioner has also preferred several representations to the respondent authorities but it has not been considered and decided till date.

3. Be that as it may, the Municipal Corporation, Raipur is directed to consider and decide the petitioner's representation and / or do the needful

for execution of the transfer deed in accordance with law expeditiously preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

4. With the aforesaid observation, the writ petition stands finally disposed of. No order as to cost(s).
