(1) Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner would submit that the petitioner's land has been acquired by respondents No.1 & 2 for the purpose of widening of Raipur-Dhamtari National Highway, in lieu of which an award has been passed on 18.07.2016 in favour of the petitioner by respondent No.3, but till date the compensation as awarded has not been disbursed by respondents No.1 & 2. The petitioner has also preferred several representations but to no avail, hence this writ petition.

(3) Be that as it may, the respondents No.1 & 2 are directed to consider the petitioner's representation and do the needful for disbursing compensation amount as awarded by respondent No.3 expeditiously preferably within a period of 45 days from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
