Learned counsel appearing on behalf of petitioner would submit that the petitioner has made an application to the respondent No. 3 – Lok Sewa Kendra, Jashpur for issuance of Domicile Certificate which has been rejected by respondent No. 3 by order dated 06.05.2017. The petitioner also made an application on 08.05.2017 for supply of certified copies of all the records of the case and copy of the order dated 06.05.2017 which has also not been supplied to the petitioner. Feeling aggrieved against which this writ petition has been preferred by the petitioner.
