3. Be that as it may, the petitioner would be at liberty to make a reference / raise a dispute before the appropriate authority under Section 35(4) of the Chhattisgarh Panchayat Raj Adhiniyam, 1993. If such a reference or dispute is raised before the appropriate authority within seven days from today then, in turn, the said authority shall do well to consider and decide the petitioner's reference / dispute expeditiously in accordance with law.
4. With the aforesaid observation, the writ petition stands finally disposed of. No order as to cost(s).
