12.01.2016 and, in that event, the Collector, Durg shall do well to consider and decide the petitioners' representation expeditiously preferably within a period of 45 days from the date of production of copy of this order.

4. With the aforesaid observation, the writ petition stands finally disposed of. No order as to cost(s).
