(1) Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner has made an application under the provisions of

Chhattisgarh Rajya Upcharyagrah Tatha Rogopchar Sambandhi Sthapnaye Anugyapan Adhiniyam, 2013 (henceforth "Adhiniyam, 2013") for registration but the same has not been considered and decided till date and, therefore, he may be permitted to file fresh application for registration and the same may be directed to be decided expeditiously.

(2) Per contra, learned counsel appearing for the State would submit that the application filed by the petitioner for registration under Adhiniyam, 2013 has been decided.

(3) I have heard learned counsel appearing for the parties.
