(4) The learned Collector has clearly recorded a finding that the petitioner did not have requisite educational qualification for the post of Lab Technician, therefore his contract period be not extended further. The finding recorded by the learned Collector is based on material available on record, in which I do not find any jurisdictional error in the impugned order.

(5) Consequently, the writ petition deserves to be and is accordingly dismissed. No order as to costs.
